

Vocal Performance Assignment

Instructions

Part 1: Student Performance Recorded in Charmsoffice.com

- You may use the web version at charmsoffice.com or the mobile app version.
- If you want to use the mobile version, download the Charms Parent/Student Portal app from your device's app store. There are two versions, so make sure you download the correct one (not the mobile administrator version).
- Log into Charmsoffice.com in the Parents/Students/Members area or use the Charms Office Parent/Student app. Enter "townviewhschoir" as your school code and your Townview Student ID as your password.
- Click on the Recording Studio.
- On the Recording Studio page, select the assignment.
- Press play to start the accompaniment and press record once you hear your starting note.
- Record the specified section of the song (which can be the whole song).
- Press stop when you are done singing.
- Play your recording to see if it can be easily heard. If not, you may need to adjust the microphone level or accompaniment level and record again. Do not adjust the tempo.
- To record again, click the X to delete your recording and repeat the process above.
- To submit your recording, click the check mark.
- Once you have submitted your recording, you may proceed to parts 2 and 3 of the VPA assignment.

Part 2: Student Self-Assessment on Vocal Performance Rubric

- Listen to your submitted recording and score yourself in each of the areas on the rubric provided. Make sure you read the rubric carefully before answering.

Part 3: One Page Student Self-Evaluation

- Write one page explaining why you gave the score you did.
- Give specific examples of each area on the rubric to justify the score you received. You may want to refer to the grading sheet for this.
